### **Insertion of Aruba to the Dutch Caribbean eAIP publication**

As per January 1<sup>st</sup> 2017, Aruba will be a member of the Dutch Caribbean AIS data originator states. DC-ANSP AIS, located in Curaçao, will hereby serve as the international AIS office for the six (6) following islands:

1. TNCA - Serving the government of Aruba
2. TNCC - Serving the government of Curaçao
3. TNCM - Serving the government of St. Maarten
4. TNCB, TNCE & TNCS - Serving the government of The Netherlands for the BES-islands

Aruba will be incorporated in the Dutch Caribbean eAIP in 2017, namely AIRAC AMDT 01-17, effective date 02 FEB 2017. The publication of this eAIP AIRAC AMDT 01-17 will take place in December of 2016.

Aruba's currently in effect AIP (AIRAC AMDT 13-2016) will remain valid until the Dutch Caribbean eAIP AIRAC AMDT 01-17 takes effect on February 2<sup>nd</sup> 2017.

### **Subscription to the 2017 Dutch Caribbean AIP publications**

As per January 2017, all eligible subscriptions to the Dutch Caribbean AIP will be free of charge. All eligible clients interested in receiving the Dutch Caribbean eAIP (TNCA, TNCC, TNCM, TNCB, TNCE, TNCS), Amendments, Supplements and AICs, are required to register and renew their subscription yearly.
